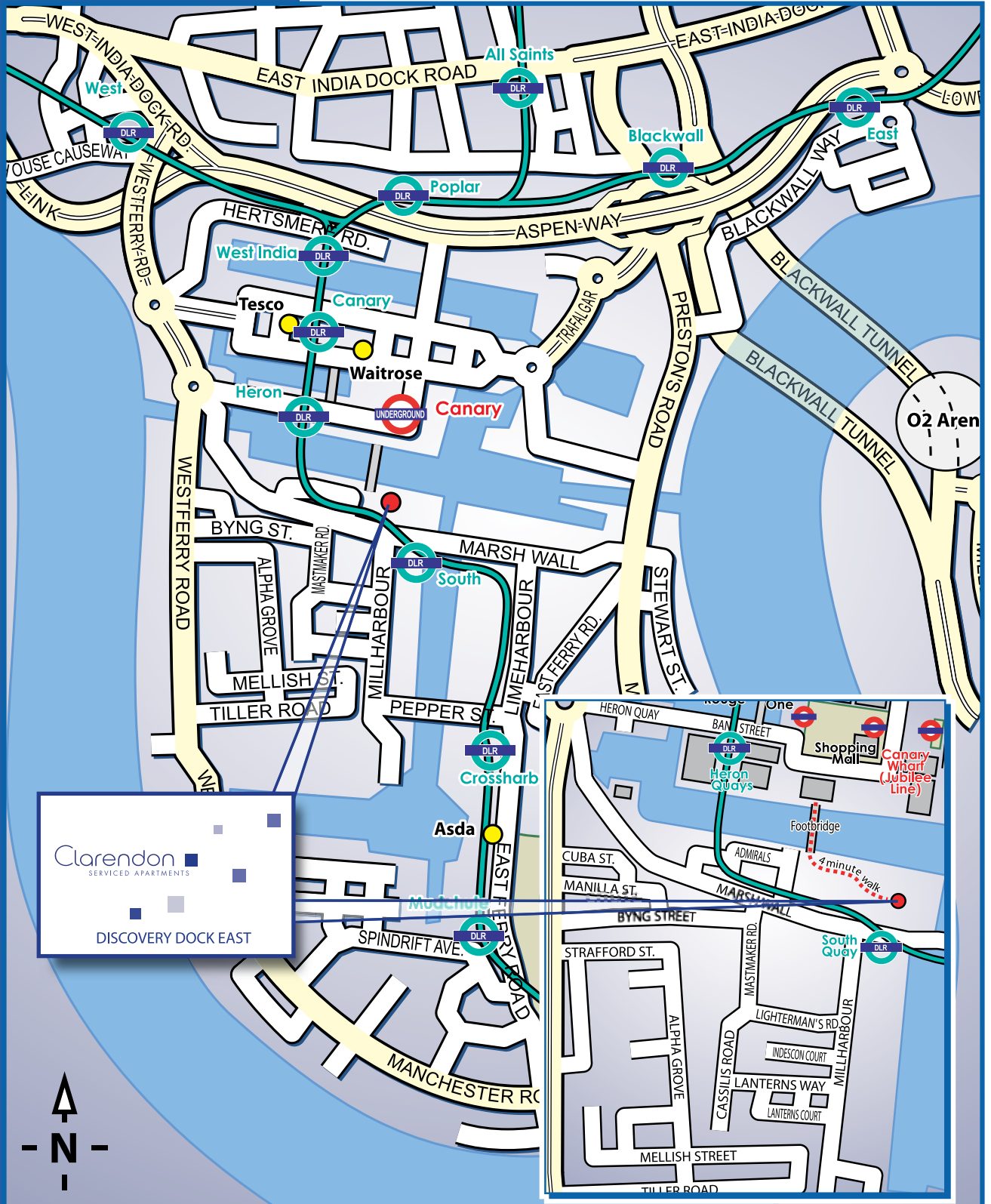

As serviced apartments in Canary Wharf go, Discovery Dock East tops the list in terms of standards, facilities and location. South Quay DLR station is a 2 minute walk and Canary Wharf offices, tube station (Jubilee Line) and shopping mall are just a 5 minute walk across the water.

There are a number of stations around Canary Wharf, all of which are on the Docklands Light Railway (DLR) which connects with larger stations such as Bank, Tower Hill, and Stratford and London City Airport, for international travel; Canary Wharf is also served by the Jubilee Line.

If the underground isn't for you then The Canary Wharf Pier is a London River Service pier on the Thames and is served by two commuter-orientated services departing on a frequent basis.





Welcome to Canary Wharf one of London's, and the world's, premier business and shopping districts. A new development, the first businesses moved-in in 1991, today it is headquarters to numerous major national and international corporations and has over 100,000 coming to work daily. The area covers 97 acres and offers 16 million square feet of office and retail space.



Before the 1980's redevelopment project began, West India Dock was one of the busiest ports in the world, with most of the cargo originating from the Canary Islands, which is how the area claimed its name. This is a city within a city, everything you need is on your doorstep, gyms, beauticians, restaurants, bars, galleries and shops – you need never leave! The council here has really made efforts to create a community spirit and an exemplary environment, as such there are many landscaped spaces and sculptural art forms improving the area aesthetically, and to perhaps encourage a more reflective mind set amongst the resident workers; whatever the motive, Canary Wharf is now host to one of the UK's largest collections of public art.



Canary Wharf boasts some of London's most contemporary and largest architectural pieces. One Canada Square is the second tallest building in London after The Shard and stands 235 meters above ground level which requires it to have a flashing warning light for aircraft in its pyramid shaped roof. It is predominantly used as office space and is a prestigious address, proved by the fact that in January 2013 the building was 100% let.





Just wondering through Canary Wharf is a cultural activity in itself; confronted by art and sculpture around every corner, 20 acres of open and park space to relax in and monumental architecture all around, there is a lot to take in. In addition to this and in a bid to create a sense of community there is a thriving Art and Events programme which includes music, dance, comedy, fashion, sport, and food and most of which are free. Whatever your interests, there will be something that will appeal to you, whether it is ice skating in the winter months or their large, alfresco 'summer screens' which televise the major sporting events of the season – come and cheer that Wimbledon finalist!

Conveniently located just across the Thames is the O2, London's state of the art concert arena which attracts some of the largest and most popular names in rock, pop, classical music as well as staging sporting events, theatrical productions like Cirque du Soleil and shows for the family. Having started life as the Millennium Dome, The O2 saved the site from demise and now the 20,000 seat arena sees sold out performances such as Barbara Streisand, The Rolling Stones and more contemporary artists including Justin Bieber and Rihanna. For those brave enough, the exterior of the dome also holds particular interest for thrill seekers and heights enthusiasts, 'Up at the O2' offers an exhilarating 90 minute walk along a platform suspended between the building's masts and breath-taking views.

If you are in need of some tranquillity and want to escape the 'rat-race' then come to the Greenwich world heritage site, where you can enjoy peaceful walks along the river or in Greenwich Park. The town itself is made up of charming independent shops and markets while the architecture is characteristically Georgian. There are many attractions and museums to visit here too, mainly focussing on the area's maritime connections; The Cutty Sark, The National Maritime Museum, The Royal Observatory and the Greenwich Meridian Line.
